

In June, we ran a summer camp in Verkhne Vysotske village, in Carpathian Mountains. To help us out with the camp, we invited a team from Volyn region. Praise God, we had around 60 children. They played games, had tasty meals, read the Bible, took part in different camp activities and competitions, discussions and workshops. The kids liked the camp very much and all of them were invited to our Sunday school.



Also, my wife and I graduated from Theological Seminary this summer. This study equipped us with priceless knowledge and skills how to carry out a missionary ministry. We are thankful to God for this opportunity.



In September, we went to Kathmandu (capital of Nepal) as missionaries. There we were helping at Christian orphanages and at a Christian school that was earlier opened by our brothers

and sisters. For two months, we were serving and helping the missionaries who carry out their ministry there on a regular basis. I would help with school renovations in the morning. After that, we would spend some time with the kids, doing homework with them, playing games, organizing different workshops. At 7 pm, they had a prayer service where the kids sang songs, worshiped God, read the Bible and contemplated on God's Word.



When we came back home, Sunday school was waiting for us with a lot of new kids who came after the summer camps. Now, we have two age groups - 9 years and 10-13 years. Teenagers also attend special Bible study groups every Thursday at 5 pm. All kids love attending these meetings.
