Our ministry is developing fast and is bringing good results. The club we started three years ago is steadily attended by 30 children. We have already cultivated good relationships with all the attendees. We reach people through their children and create more connections between the club and the Church. Since October, we have started conducting musical training courses. Guitar, drum and vocals classes were available. Through this ministry, we want to help children and young people to develop their talents and find their true passions. Children are usually very interested in music and eagerly attend the classes.



Youth ministry is also rapidly growing. This year, we have baptized three young people who had repented at the summer camp. Young members of the church have chosen Sasha Galko, who had recently finished Bible school, a youth leader. He is currently undergoing probation period to become a youth pastor. Social ministry

is also going well. Mostly, we help low-income families. The children were able to spend their summer vacation at the camp for free. Parents attend Church and their kids visit Sunday school. One guy enrolled to the university with our help and his mom was very grateful. He had been included in our social project since childhood.



We had perfect time at the summer camps and also organized various evangelistic events in the area. We visited Gypsy villages, brought the people living there some help and gifts for children. In addition, for young families with the kids we organized a festive picnic in the park on the International Father's Day.
