We invited not only members of the church, but also parents of the children studying at school, work colleagues and friends. Eventually, four women joined the group. Our courses not only help us teach people to raise their children in the right manner, but also lead them to God. We pray that God will become their personal Savior!



Three years ago, we met Sergiy and invited him to attend a training course called "Fundamentals of Christian Life." Subsequently, he and his son repented and they together were baptized in our church. The following year, his wife accepted Christ and was baptized. This

wonderful family participates in Bible study groups at Biblical Institute every year. The family runs a Sunday school and actively serves to disabled children. I firmly believe that through them God reaches the hearts of these children's parents. Two women, mothers of the kids, have already repented and made a covenant with the Lord.



I also continue to actively serve all over Lviv region - organize various groups, conferences, and counsel young ministry leaders. That way people involved in various ministries can work together and double their efforts. A few years ago, our brother Vladimir began to attend one of my groups, and recently he was ordained to a presbyterian ministry in one of the churches.
