So, now we have open questions about his future. In addition, his skin problems due to his allergies make the situation worse. To put it simple, if he goes to serve in Ukrainian army, he has serious problems with the US laws: loss of citizenship or even jail.



Other kids are doing fine. Our precious Yana is over 6 months old. She is just one very happy jewel. Still no teeth. We hardly ever have a sleepless night with her. Olya is doing fine. We do feel that having 7th child at the age of 39 is different from having babies when little over 20 years old.

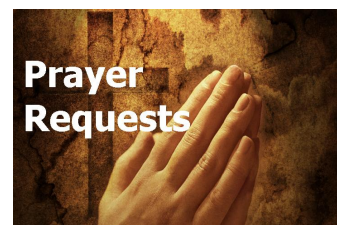
