

- This world is broken and filled with people who hurt
- God put you and me here to make this world a better place

Dear friends.

Her drug-addicted mother abandons six year old Halya and her two year old brother for weeks at a time.

Their home is a makeshift tent Halya has constructed out of cardboard and branches she found in the forest. Which is where they live.

Halya's mother has given her instructions on how to get food... 'either beg or steal from merchants at a nearby produce market.'

Imagine a six year old charged with the responsibility

of keeping herself and her younger sibling alive without any adult assistance. My own daughter is six. To me this situation is unimaginable.

Ira was five years old when she was sold by her mother to a gypsy baron for several cases of vodka. For years she was forced to beg for her owner and by the age of ten was raped by him and subsequently, on a regular basis, by his sons. She attempted to escape once, but was caught and beaten senseless.

Ninety percent of all child

pornography finds it origins in Ukraine, Russia and Belarus. Against their will, children are pulled

out of orphanages and used in porn movies.

I suspect if we were honest with ourselves we'd ask the question, 'Does God see the tears of sorrow and despair streaming down the cheeks of children like Ira and Halya? Does God see the injustice done to innocent children around the world?'

Fifteen years of ministry in third world countries has led me to conclude several things.

Firstly, this world is truly broken and filled with people who hurt. Its filled with places of hell on earth.

But I'm also convinced that "God loves justice" and wants to use His people to "seek justice, rescue the oppressed, defend the orphan and plead for the widow." (Isaiah 1:17)

In other words...YOU and I are part of God's plan for ending injustice in the world.

When Jesus left, He asked that you and I make this world a little bit more beautiful, to share a little bit more of His love and to take a little bit of heaven to places of hell on earth.

Did God hear the cries of Halya and Ira? Yes. Both of these children were saved by the Father's House, (a HART

partner in Kyiv, Ukraine) a ministry dedicated to rescuing street kids and abandoned children.

Halya was adopted to a Christian family in Germany, her brother to a family in Georgia. Within a year the family in Georgia decided to immigrate to Germany and through circumstances only God can orchestrate, the two siblings were reunited through a 'chance' meeting of the parents!

Ira, today is happily married and the mother of two children.

But for the involvement of Christians who care, both of these stories may have ended tragically different.

God has compassion for those who suffer injustice. He hears their cries. He sees the tears of every child who is being abused right now even as you are reading these words.

Our grateful thanks to YOU for working alongside HART as we respond to the issues of poverty, injustice and oppression in our world.

New HART partner in Moldova

BEGINNING OF LIFE

Director: Vladimir Ubeivolc **Location:** Chisinau, Moldova

Overview:

BEGINNING OF LIFE is a Christian agency whose focus is on the prevention of social problems in society, especially among the youth...and the rehabilitation of those who are damaged physically, emotionally and spiritually because of their horrific life experiences.

BEGINNING OF LIFE...began its activities in 2000, working with single pregnant women who wanted to abort their babies. In 2006 they initiated programs such as prevention of human trafficking and support for HIV positive women. A program supporting victims of domestic violence began in 2008. Beginning of Life established a rehabilitation and reintegration center for victims of human trafficking and sexual exploitation in January 2009.



Anti-trafficking program

- Raising awareness in churches, schools and government
- Center (safe house) for rehabilitation and reintegration of the victims of human trafficking
- Support, education and counseling for high risk girls from volatile family environments



Support for women

- Counseling and support for victims of domestic violence
- Abortion counseling and prevention
- Single mothers: material, financial and counseling support for young girls who elect not to abort their babies



Prevention programs in public schools

- Ministry to high school students: lectures on alcohol and drugs, human trafficking, HIV/AIDS, sexual immorality, abortions
- Educating teachers and parents
- Publishing a youth magazine intended to create a positive, Christian worldview in young people of Eastern Europe



Moldova

Sandwiched between Romania and Ukraine, Moldova emerged as an independent republic following the collapse of the USSR in 1991.

Suffering from exactly the same corruption and cronyism that also plagues Ukraine, Moldova is considered the poorest country in Europe with a large foreign debt and high unemployment.

It is estimated that about a third of Moldova's 4.5 million people (50% of its labour force) have left to work abroad, most of them illegally. But more than half of the migrants to Europe are women, who are often forced to leave their children behind.

Because of emigration, 100,000 children across Moldova (30% of all children) are growing up without one parent, or even both. They are considered "social" orphans.

Since the government has no political will to educate or protect them, the only alternative is to leave the country at any price.

Many are drawn into the sex trade simply by trying to escape a country without a future.

Field Note

On one of our frequent road trips to visit HART partners this summer, we travelled to Chisinau, the capital of Moldova, where we had the privilege of examining Beginning of Life's ministry. Our team came away very impressed with the leadership, breadth and vision of this ministry. We consider this to be one of the premier ministries of its kind in Eastern Europe.

HART is excited about this new partnership, especially because of our opportunity to assist this ministry's expansion into Ukraine, Belarus and Russia. Please keep 'Beginning of Life' in prayer and consider supporting this amazing ministry. LC
