Let me share some stories and testimonies from our ministry.

Starting from May 20th, my husband went to Kyiv for 2 weeks. He had some training at Campus Crusades for Christ organization. Also, he was able to visit the church he had planted, to spend some time with his disciples and to participate in church "soul winning". It was awesome time to meet new people in the church and to see how God is growing and nurturing His church.



Roman visited Arab church (the pastor of this church also is Roman's former disciple), he spent lots of time with pastor's family, some people from this church and participated at train station ministry. Every week this church goes to main train station and feed poor people (beggars), listen their stories and share the Gospel with them.



Also, Roman met with our friend and disciple Lena. She is a teacher and she also is involved in Crossroads ministry with us. Here is her short testimony: "The Crossroads ministry first was a very good methodological instrument for me to use at school. I was excited to teach my

students this program. Back in 2005, I was a secular teacher and just liked the Crossroads program, not realizing fully how spiritually strong it was. After some time of introducing it to the kids, I've noticed that it was impacting me, too. I started communicating more with the Crossroads program trainers, especially Albina Grodz, and asking them crucial questions. Soon, I opened my heart to God. My husband Yura also came to knowing Christ thanks to the Grodz family and this wonderful program. Now I realize how blessed my family is to know these godly people and through their help and prayers gain salvation and a new life."



Meanwhile, I moved to my grandmother's home and took care of her. She was 88 and she needed care and help. When she couldn't walk and it got very hard for me to look after 2 kids and a bedridden grandma, I asked Roma to come back to Lviv. We spent one more day together and while Roma was praying over her she passed away peacefully to be with the Lord. Praise God!
