Liubov's Calling to Care for Ukraine's Sickest Children

My name is **Liubov Kulinich**, and I serve as a paediatrician at the National Cancer Institute of Ukraine in Kyiv—something I once thought would only be a dream.

I'm the fifth of eight children in a hardworking but financially struggling family. When I was accepted into medical school in Vinnytsia in 2016, we didn't know how we'd afford it. My dream seemed out of reach.



That's when God intervened—through the generosity of HART's Educational Scholarship Fund. It changed everything!

From 2017 to 2021, your support lifted a huge burden from my family and allowed me to focus on my calling. I had always dreamed of becoming a paediatric oncologist, and every step since then has been guided by God's hand.

After passing my final exams, a friend called unexpectedly to tell me there was a rare opening in paediatric oncology. It was a miracle—this type of position is nearly impossible to secure, especially without connections. But I trusted God, and He opened the door.



Today, I work in Kyiv at the National Cancer Institute - where I care for some of Ukraine's most vulnerable children—those battling cancer with courage beyond their years. It is both heart-wrenching and deeply meaningful. More than anything, I want to be a source of hope, not only medically but spiritually. I pray that God will give me the wisdom to share the Gospel with families facing their darkest moments.

In addition to my hospital work, I mentor girls at Christian summer camps and recently joined the HART Educational Fund team. It's an honor to give back to the very organization that helped launch my journey.

Looking ahead, I dream of working

at *Timoshi's Smile*, a Christian cancer center now under construction. There, I hope to continue blending medicine and ministry—offering holistic care to children and families facing their hardest battles. I pray that God will give me wisdom to share the Gospel with them.

As I reflect on my journey, I see God's hand in every step. God opened doors I thought were impossible. And HART was one of the greatest blessings along the way.
